What kind of training program do you offer and what does it entail? (be very specific)

Is training required for members?

What is the qualifications/certifications of the training staff who will provide instructions?

How quickly can I get trained after I join?

Is there a comprehensive and official Rules and Regulations document available ... and if yes, may I have a copy?

Can my attorney review the Rules and Regulations?

May I review your insurance summary and Certificate of Insurance?

Do you offer liability insurance coverage for your members? If yes, how much is provided?

Do you offer hull and machinery insurance coverage? If yes, how much is provided?

Is towing insurance coverage available? How much is it?

What is the entry fee to join?

What are the membership plan options that are available and their prices?

Once I join the club, can you raise my monthly dues?

What types of social events are available for your club members and how often are they held?

Can I bring my friends and family boating with me ... and my dog?

Can you provide a list of local member testimonials or contact information from people who live in my market?
